Señora Rosa Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile £6.50 £23.00 Delicious, fruit-driven red. Fresh, fruity and smooth.		
Botter Merlot del Veneto, Italy £23.00 Medium-bodied, easy-drinking wine with plenty of colour, fruit and mouthfeel, which can be enjoyed young.		
Red Rock Shiraz, Australia £23.00 Rich, savoury Shiraz from South-Eastern Australia with dark chocolate and white pepper on the finish.		
Hanger & Flank Malbec, Argentina £25.00 Deep coloured, dark berry fruits and a smooth, juicy finish.		
De Waal Pinotage, South Africa £25.50 Pinotage is unique to South Africa – the result of a 1925 crossing between Pinot Noir and Cinsault in Stellenbosch. The De Waal family were one of the very first wineries to plant the varietal commercially, and the De Waal Pinotage reflects an elegant, modern style with silky texture with nice smoky notes and lush brambles.		
Beronia Rioja Crianza, Spain £28.00 Made from 82% Tempranillo, 14% Garnacha and 4% Mazuelo. The wine is aged twelve months in barrel and twelve months in bottle prior to release. Aromas of vanilla, raspberry and cherry dominate the bouquet. The palate is fresh and fruity with a rich and powerful finish. IWC Commended.		

White Wine

The Cove Chenin Blanc, South Africa £6.50 £23.00
 With subtle, diverse flavours and an appealing structure, it is by far South Africa's most iconic white varietal because of its adaptability. Look for hints of peach fruit drops, white flowers and soft hints of spice.

Botter Pinot Grigio, Italy £23.00
 An intense straw colour with an ample, lasting, fruity bouquet. The palate is dry, soft and well-balanced.

Los Gansos Vignier, Chile £24.00
 This wine is like a sensual embrace on your tongue, with luscious flavours that will make you swoon. It's the perfect partner for a spicy curry. Sip it and feel yourself falling in love.

Le Versant Chardonnay, France £27.00
 A fresh pale lemon colour, with a full, round, fresh, fruity bouquet of citrus and lemon fruits. The palate is light and elegant with balancing acidity and a clean finish.

Seifried Estate 'Old Coach Road' Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand £29.00
 Named after the road along the ridge through the middle of the Moutere vineyards used for mail deliveries from the 1850s, this excellent example of Herman Seifried's winemaking shows a honeyed, floral, sweet Sauvignon bouquet and then loads of fruit in a fresh, dry, zesty flavour with nuances of gooseberry and melon.

Rosé Wine

Señora Rosa Cabernet Rosé, Chile £6.50 £23.00
 Bursting with summer fruits, this refreshing wine is an ideal apéritif.

La Casada Rose Pinot Grigio, Italy £27.00
 An oddity of the wine world that is wonderfully refreshing, with crisp acidity backed up by pleasant soft, red fruit flavours.
